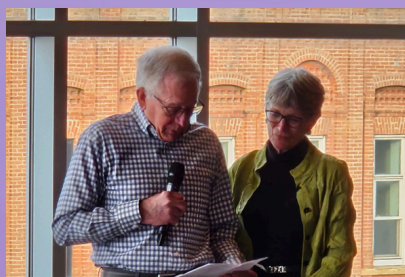
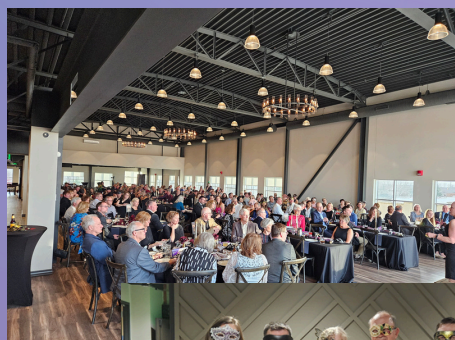
40TH ANNUAL CHARITY EVENT & AUCTION

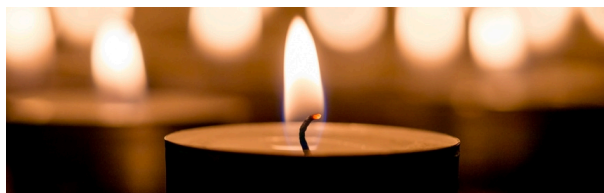

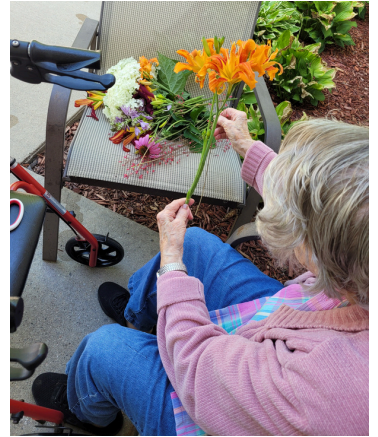


Uncovering what makes us shine!
